Boots & Riding Shoes

Check Prior To Use:

Before using these boots, make sure they are in good condition. In case of visible damage like breakage, tears, unstitching, etc., they must be replaced. The boots protect properly only when in good condition and correctly worn: The level of protection is effective as long as the items maintain their original characteristics. Therefore, it is important that no modifications or repairs are made: Do not tamper with your boots.

If the fastening devices consist of strips, straps, elastic bands, hooks or the like, both their efficiency and their sealing must be verified. If a Velcro closure is present, it should be checked for wear and tightness at regular intervals.

Care & Washing Instructions:

- Removing Dirt: Use a damp cloth to wipe away dirt and debris. For heavier soiling, use a damp cloth or soft brush with lukewarm water (maximum 104°F/40°C).
- Leather Care: Use specific products designed for cleaning and maintaining leather materials.

Important Guidelines

- Avoid washing under running water.
- Never use boiling water, solvents, or harsh chemicals for cleaning.
- Keep the boots or shoes away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and moisture.
- Do not tamper with any parts of the boots or shoes.

Storage and Drying

- After use, allow the boots or shoes to dry naturally in a well-ventilated area at room temperature.
- Avoid using dryers, blow dryers, or other heating devices to dry the footwear.
- Store in a dry, well-ventilated space when not in use.

If the boots are damaged, or if there is any doubt about their condition, they should be replaced immediately.
